## BEHIND THE INSPIRATION

Having worked with Rave Scott on the real estate side for years, we were excited to hear from her about how she turned inspiration into design reality in her beautiful home.

"I collected inspiration from various sources. creating boards on Houzz & Pinterest to gather my ideas. My goal was to create a more contemporary look to update a 12 year old unit. I wanted to design furniture that was the right size and scale for a condo and would still allow a feeling of space and light. The sofo, ottomans and dining table chairs were custom made locally from photos I found. I loved the idea of the 3 cube shaped ottomans for additional seating that fit perfectly under the window seat when not in use.

Construction wise the very first thing I did was have all the ceilings smooth textured. This not only updates the look but, it makes the ceilings feel 6 inches higher. I added LED lighting behind the coved crown molding and under lighting for the window seat, kitchen island and built-in wall unit. Lighting is very important to me and I love creating different moods and accenting my art collection with great lighting. Many of my custom built-in work was done by Dave Fiedler of DF Designs. He is an extraordinary cabinet maker.

In the end I borrowed ideas from several sources, took some risks and trusted my instincts!"
